Frozen Yogurt Teddy Treats

Prep Time: 20 min
 Total Time: 4 hr 20 min
 Makes: 9
 2-1/4 cups TEDDY GRAHAMS Cinnamon Graham Snacks, divided
 1-1/2 qt. (6 cups) frozen nonfat yogurt, any flavor, divided
 1 cup sliced fresh strawberries
 1 cup banana slices
 COOL WHIP LITE Whipped Topping, thawed (optional)

ARRANGE 1 cup of the graham snacks on bottom of foil-lined 8-inch square pan. Cover with layers of 2 cups of the yogurt and strawberries. Top with layers of 2 cups of the remaining yogurt and bananas.
 STIR 1 cup of the graham snacks into remaining 2 cups yogurt; spread over banana layer.
 Cover. Freeze 4 hours or until firm.
 REMOVE from pan. Cut into squares. Garnish with remaining graham snacks just before serving. Top with whipped topping.

NCAA - 7-8 year olds 60-100 pounds and 9 year olds 60-74 pounds

AFC - 9 year olds 75-120 pounds, 10 year olds 70-110 pounds and 11 year olds 75-89 pounds.

NFC - 11-12 year olds 90-140 pounds and 10 year olds 111-140 pounds.
